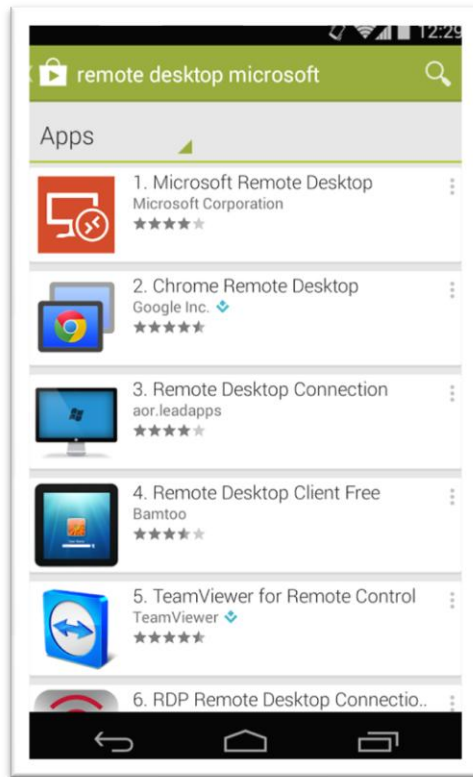

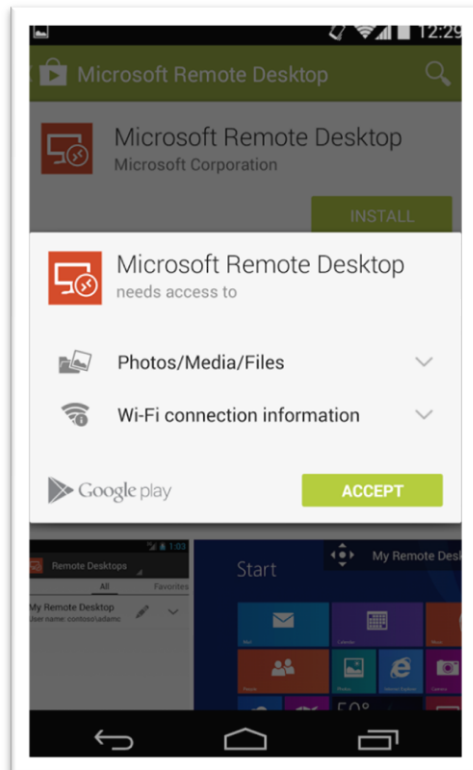
Android device User Instructions

Instructions for accessing cloud based CONTACTfile.

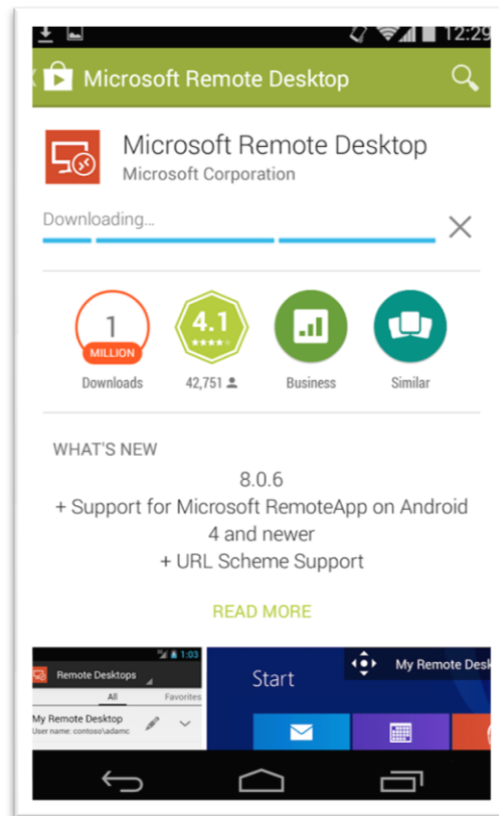
1. Open the Google Play Store and search for 'Remote Desktop Microsoft'



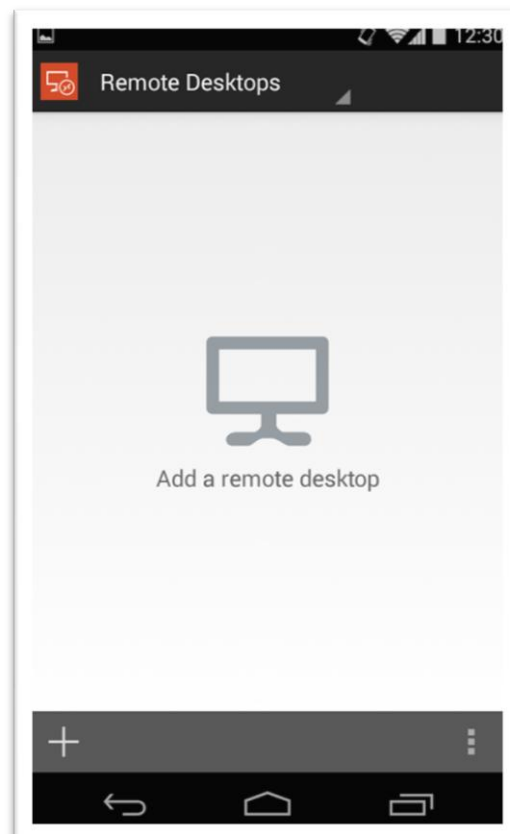
2. Select the first result and then click install. Accept the permissions.



3. The application will then download.




4. Once downloaded and installed open the application. It should look like this.




5. Select the add icon in the bottom left hand corner of the app. You will then need to populate the following details:

- Connection name: ContactFile
- PC Name: cloud1.freemanitconsulting.co.uk
- User name: As provided
- Password: As provided
